1. **Title of the Practice:** Voting Awareness Programme

2. **Objectives of the Practice:** The objective of this program is to make students aware about voting so that they all can participate enthusiastically in this celebration of democracy and understand their responsibility towards the country.

Every year, 200-250 students become new voters from our organization and through these children and the people from remote areas, we They work to spread awareness in the areas and organize various programs to understand the importance of voting like cycle rally, rangoli competition, speeches, essay writing etc.

5. **Evidence of Success:** Apart from the college students, students from nearby schools also participated enthusiastically in this program and gave a message to the society about what is the role of voting for our country, for our state, for our society. And for us, due to all these programs, we can say that people here have now started believing in democracy and have started voting, the proof of which is that the voting percentage has also started increasing here and as soon as the age of 18 years, the voters start voting id cards .



Best Practice – 2

1. **Title of the Practice:** Women Empowerment and Employment Generation, Awareness Program.

2. **Objectives of the Practice:** To make students aware of the broader dimensions of women's empowerment and employment in the region through this program.

3. **The Context:** The aim of higher education is not only to impart academic knowledge but also to create an environment where the students can realize the importance of community welfare and involve in such activities which help in bringing about a change in their outlook towards human lives.

After completing her studies from here, she is going to work at different places, some in her village and some outside the village (like Smart, Teacher, Women Support Group etc.)

The result of all these programs of ours is that now the women of this area are participating equally in the society and understand the importance of economic strengthening at home and society.
