- Registering 200-250 new voters annually from among the college students.
- Encouraging these students to spread awareness in surrounding areas, particularly in remote communities.
- Organizing various events to emphasize the importance of voting, such as:
 - **Cycle rallies**
 - **Rangoli competitions**
 - **Speeches and debates**
 - **Essay writing competitions**

These initiatives aim to engage students and the broader community in understanding the critical role of voting in shaping the future of the nation.


5. Evidence of Success

The program focuses on educating students and the local community about various initiatives undertaken by the Central Government, State Government, and District Administration. The key elements include:


- Detailed information about government programs, their objectives, and the benefits they offer.

Through these initiatives, our college has become a platform for nurturing talent and empowering women, fostering a culture of equality, self-reliance, and social contribution.


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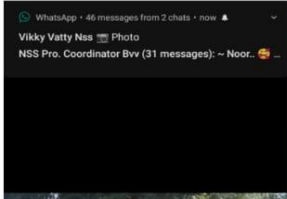




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
